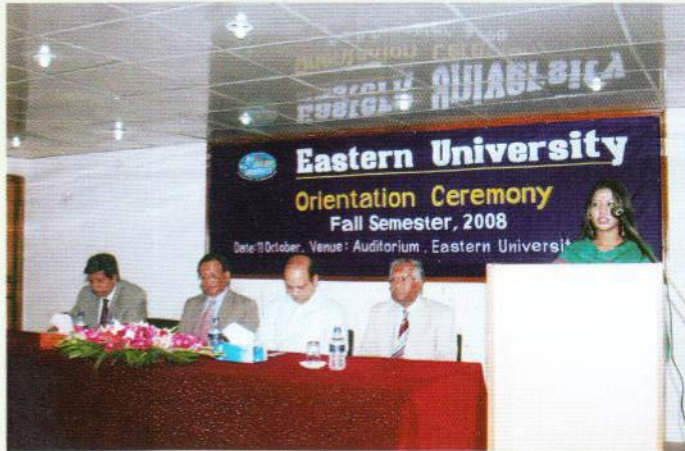

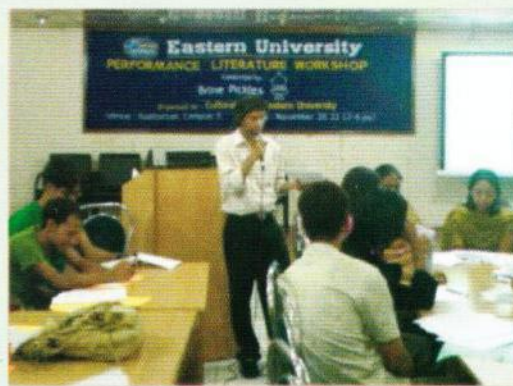


Seminar on Melamine in the Food Chain

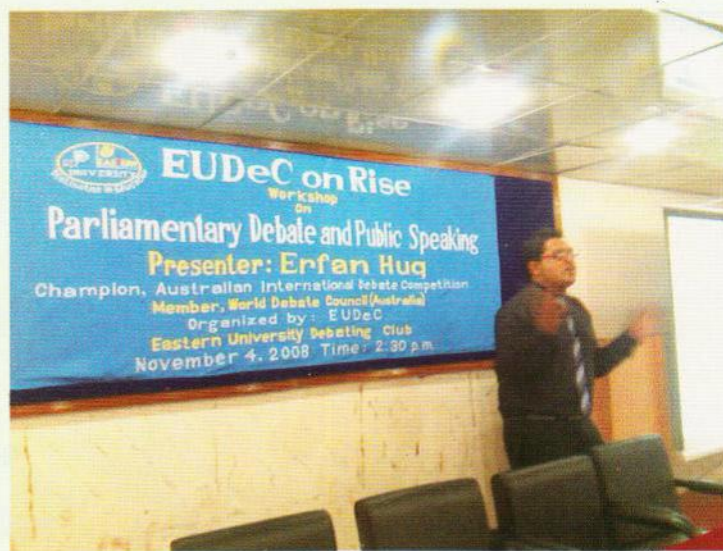
Distribution of Winter Clothes by the Social Welfare Club

Eastern University Debating Club on Rise

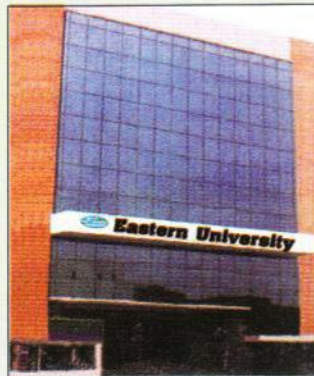

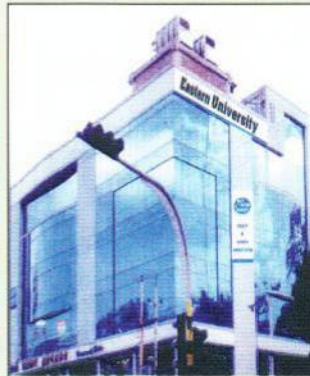

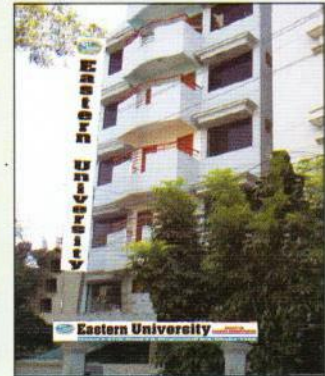
Main Campus
